Living the Gospel by helping those with addictions

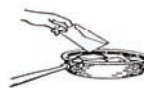

Next Sunday, April 22 is ShareLife Sunday. Please give generously.



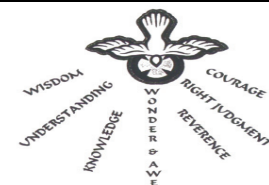
HOLY FAMILY STATUE
