2018 was another challenging year for a lot of people but most especially the poor of our Parish who struggle daily to put food on the table and make ends meet. DOCTRINAL CORNER

Are we still obliged to observe the Eucharistic fast?

Yes, we are. Canon 919 states: "Whoever is to receive the blessed Eucharist is to abstain for at least one hour before Holy Communion from all food and drink, with the sole exception of water and medicine."

Fasting is different from dieting, so even if your coffee, tea or juice is sugar-free, you should still not drink any of it at least an hour before Holy Communion. Food means anything that is: a) edible, b) taken by mouth, and c) swallowed. In addition to breakfast, lunch, dinner and snack, "food" refers to candies, breath mints, lozenges and anything that is put into the mouth to be dissolved or chewed and swallowed. Chewing gum is not swallowed but once the juice is swallowed, the fast is broken.
