DOCTRINAL CORNER

Does a baptized Catholic who has received his first confession and his first Commuion need to be confirmed to be married in the Catholic Church?

Catholics who have not yet received the sacrament of Confirmation are to receive it before being admitted to marriage, if this can be done without grave inconvenience." (Code of Canon Law # 1065).

Which sins must be confessed?

All grave (mortal) sins not yet confessed, which a careful examination of conscience brings to mind, **must** be brought to the sacrament of Penance. The confession of serious sins is the only ordinary way to obtain forgiveness.
