DOCTRINAL CORNER

What is the difference between the Roman Catholic and the Catholic religions?

The Catholic religion/church comprises all churches in communion with the Pope. If a group or a community does not adhere to the Pope, it is not part of the Catholic Church. There are a number of individual self-governing churches called *rites*, the largest of which is the Roman or Latin rite. which includes most Catholics in the west (more than 1.1 billion). There are 23 other rites, (total members: 19 million), like the Maronite, Ukraine Greek Catholic, Chaldean, Syro-Malabar, etc. that can be called Catholics but not Roman Catholics. They are Maronite Catholics, Ukrainian Catholics, etc. They are all as Catholic as everyone else since they are in full communion with the Pope. All the rites are equal, their ecclesial customs and traditions may be different but the doctrines are all the same.
