Special Collection: Pope's Pastoral Works – May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019


POPE'S PASTORAL WORKS: This collection was established by

#### Does Jesus suffer each time we sin?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Since our sins made the Lord suffer the torment of the cross, those who plunge themselves into disorders and crimes crucify the Son of God anew in their hearts and hold Him up to contempt. Our crime in this case is greater in us than in the Jews who, according to the witness of the Apostle, "None of the rulers of this age understood this, for if they had they would not have crucified the Lord of glory." We, however, profess to know him. And when we deny Him by our deeds, we, in some way, seem to lay violetn hands on Him. Nor did the demons crucify Him; it is you who have crucified Him and crucify Him still". (CCC 598, quoting St. Francis of Assisi).
