DOCTRINAL CORNER

Why is St. Paul referred to as an apostle when clearly he was not one of the twelve?

An apostle is one who is sent forth. St. Paul was clearly sent forth by Jesus, entrusted with a mission. In the Lord's own words, Paul became "a chosen instrument of mine to carry my name before the Gentiles and kings and the sons of Israel" (Acts 9:15). Paul refers to himself as an apostle many times in the New Testament, and even defends his apostleship in his first letter to the Corinthians (1 Cor. 9:1-2).


