

DOCTRINAL CORNER

Are any apparitions ever considered dogma?

No. Apparitions and locutions are considered "private revelation", and while some have been recognized by the Church, they do not belong to the deposit of faith. Catholics are not bound to believe Church-approved private revelations. The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains the role of private revelations as follows: "It is not their role to improve or complete Christ's definitive revelation but to help *live more fully by it in a certain period of history... Christian faith* cannot accept "revelations" that claim to surpass or correct the revelation of which Christ is the fulfillment..." (CCC67)
