# DOCTRINAL CORNER

#### May one who has not received the sacrament of Confirmation be a baptism/confirmation sponsor?

**NO.** Canon Law states that to be a sponsor one has to: 1) be designated by the person receiving the sacrament or by the parents/guardians or, in their absence, the minister; 2) have completed the 16<sup>th</sup> year of age, unless; 3) be a practicing Catholic who has been **confrmed** and has **received the Eucharist**; 4) not bound by any canonical penalty imposed or declared; 5) **not** the father or mother of the one receiving the sacrament.

A non-Catholic Christian may be admitted only in company with a Catholic sponsor, and only as a **witness.** (Canon 874).
