# DOCTRINAL CORNER

The Church's teaching on the immorality of invitro fertilization seems cruel and unfair. Don't married couples have a right to have a child?

Children are a gift, not an entitlement. The Church teaches that marriage does not confer upon the spouses the right to have a child, but only the right to perform those natural acts which are per se ordered to procreation. The child is not an object to which one has a right, nor can be considered as an object of ownership; rather, a child is a gift, the supreme gift and the most gratuitous gift of marriage, and is a living testimony of the mutual giving of his parents. (Instruction on the Respect for Human Life 8) The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us that artificial insemination, fertilization, etc. dissociate the sexual act from the procreative act. The act which brings the child into existence is no longer an act by which two persons give themselves to one another. but one that entrusts the life and identity of the embryo into the power of doctors and biologists and establishes the domination of technology over the origin and destiny of the human person. Such a relationship of domination is in itself contrary to the dignity and equality that must be common to parents and children. (CCC 2377)

Can I risk sharing the goodness God has given me? Can I care for the needs of my brothers and sisters? Can I respond to God as a priest, deacon. brother or sister?
