

# DOCTRINAL CORNER

#### Can angels appear in the shape of animals?

An angel is pure spirit, and as such, has no shape. But for the purpose of interacting with us, an angel may at times assume a shape in order to fulfill the purpose God intends for the angel to accomplish. God the Holy Spirit was willing to appear as a dove (*Mt. 3:16, Mk 1:10, Lk 3:22, Jn 1:32*). There is no reason in principle that an angel could not appear in animal form.

# Why is the Pope called the *"Holy Father"* instead of just *"Father"*?

We refer to him as the "*Holy Father*" not as an acknowledgement of the personal state of his soul but as an expression of respect for this office as successor of Peter and head of the Church on earth. His is a holy office.
