
Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults An interview with the Pastor is mandatory.





#### Can we pray directly to God or must all prayers go through Jesus?

There is a distinction between prayer addressed to God the Father (e.g. "The Our Father") and prayer having access to the Father. We should also understand that our prayers have access to the Father only through Jesus, for He proclaimed. "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father but by me." (John 14:16).
