Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

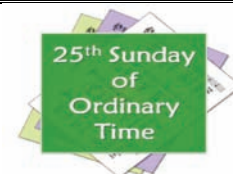

DOCTRINAL CORNER

Can I have a Mass in a park or in my home or a place not in the Church?

The Archdiocese of Toronto does not endorse Masses celebrated in a private home. "The celebration of the Eucharist is to be carried out in a sacred place, unless in a particular case necessity requires otherwise. In this case the celebration must be in a decent place." (*Code of Canon Law, c.932*) Note that "it is never lawful for a priest to celebrate in a temple or sacred place of any non-Christian religion".
