Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

ARCHDIOCESE ANNUAL MASS ATTENDANCE COUNT



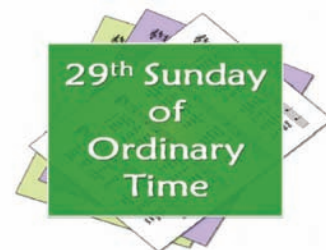

I have celiac disease? What do I do?

In consultation with your parish priest and your physician, there are at least two options: 1. you may receive a “low-gluten” host if available, or 2. you may receive Holy Communion from the chalice, instead of the host. Make sure that you refrain from drinking the priest’s chalice because of the small amount of the host in the wine under the fraction rite.
