DOCTRINAL CORNER

How long after the birth of a child should the Baptism take place?

As soon as possible after the birth: Parents are obliged to see to it that infants are baptized within the first weeks after birth. As soon as possible after the birth or even before it, parents are to go to the parish to request the sacrament for their child and to be prepared for it properly (*Code of Canon Law*, *c.867* § 1). An infant in danger of death is to be baptized without any delay (*Code of Canon Law*, *c.867* § 2).

REFLECTIONS ON STEWARDSHIP
