#### REFLECTIONS ON STEWARDSHIP

St. Elizabeth of the Trinity famously prayed to God saying, "Grant my soul peace. Make it your heaven, your beloved dwelling and the place of your rest. May I never abandon you there, but may I be there, whole and entire" We are called to make a home for the Trinity within us, but how can we practically do this? Our Lord Jesus gives us the answer in John 14 where He says: "Those who love me will keep my word, and my Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them."

### DOCTRINAL CORNER

How do we arrange to have our child baptized in a parish other than the one where we normally worship?

If, for a good pastoral reason (for example, so extended family may attend), parents wish to have their child baptized at another parish, they need to approach the Pastor of that parish to ask if he is willing to baptize their child. A letter of permission to have the baby baptized elsewhere must be obtained from the Pastor of the parish where the family usually worships. Normally, Baptism preparation may take place in either of the parishes.
