

# DOCTRINAL CORNER

Does my separation and civil divorce, prohibit me from receiving Holy Communion?

"Anyone who desires to receive Christ in Eucharist communion must be in the state of grace. Anyone aware of having sinned mortally must not receive communion without having received absolution in the sacrament of penance." (CCC:1415). If the divorced are remarried civilly, the Church maintains that the new union cannot be recognized as valid if the first marriage is valid: "they cannot receive Eucharistic communion as long as this situation persists". (CCC: 1650).

# If I'm a non-Catholic, what procedures and protocols should I observe when I go to Mass?

We ask that you respectfully observe the parish community at Mass, and that you follow along as the community prays, sings, reads, sits, stands, and exchages greetings with one another in the presence of Jesus Christ.
