DOCTRINAL CORNER

Can I have a Mass in a park or in my home or a place not in the Church?

The Archdiocese of Toronto does not endorse Masses celebrated in a private home. "The celebration of the Eucharist is to be carried out in a sacred place, unless in a paritcular case necessity requires otherwise. In this case the celebration must be in a decent place." (Code of Canon Law, c.932) Note that "it is never lawful for a priest to celebrate in a temple or sacred place of any non-Christian religion". [5] For more detail please consult Celebration of Holy Mass Outside of a Sacred Space Protocol.
