# Are you able to host a Ukrainian family?

When hearing reports of the war in Ukraine, and the millions of Ukrainians that have been forced to flee their homeland, many have asked what they can do to help. Over 200,000 Ukrainians have already arrived in Canada through a special visa program created by Immigration Canada. An additional 800,000 have applied to the program and are expected to arrive in the coming months. Many are arriving to Toronto and are without family here in Canada to help them. Among those will be some who are vulnerable to human trafficking, particularly seniors, single women, and women with children. There is an immediate need for families to host for a period of between one and six months some of those who have arrived. ## DOCTRINAL CORNER

#### When did Jesus Christ institute the Eucharist?

Jesus instituted the Eucharist on Holy Thursday "*the night on which he was betrayed*" (1 Corinthians 11:23), as he celebrated the Last Supper with his apostles. (Compendium, 272)

#### What is the meaning of transubstantiation?

A wonderful change of the ordinary bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ takes place during the Church's eucharistic prayer through the efficacious word of Christ and by the action of the Holy Spirit. (Compendium, 283) This is a mystery of faith. "*Christ himself, living and* glorious, is present in a true, real, and substantial manner: his Body and his Blood, with his sould and his divinity." (CCC:1413)



### **REFLECTIONS ON STEWARDSHIP**

In today's first reading we hear the biblical roots of Confirmation as some believers receive the Holy Spirit after Peter and John lay their hands on them. The Second Vatican Council says that Confirmation, and the receiving of the Holy Spirit, makes us obliged to spread the Gospel through "*word and deed*." Let us strive to do this in our parish communities as a way of living out our call of Confirmation and let us do so by turning to the Holy Spirit to guide us.
