Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

An interview with the Pastor to set the baptism date is mandatory. Following the interview, attendance by the Parents and Catholic Godparents at Baptism Preparation Class, held every First Saturday of the month, is required. Parents of the child to be baptized are expected to be active members of the Parish community.

Marriage One year notice is normally required to prepare to receive this sacrament. Please contact the Parish Office to schedule a meeting with Msgr. Edgardo Pan, PH for an initial interview.

Pastoral Care of the Sick. Requests for visitation of the sick and/or to receive the sacraments for the sick and homebound are to be made through the Parish Office. In times of emergency or beyond regular office hours, please contact a Priest in person.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults An interview with the Pastor is mandatory.

REFLECTIONS ON STEWARDSHIP

As Jesus calls the apostles, He uses their own language by inviting them to be *"fishers of people."* There is a deep spiritual insight that can be gleaned from this, namely, that Christ uses what we bring to the table to serve Him and the Church. This is the heart of stewardship, so let us reflect on our own gifts and graciously heed the call of Christ to become *"fishers of people,"* each in our own way.

DOCTRINAL CORNER

Is it possible for our child to be baptized even if we are not married?

Catholic parents, or Catholics married to non-Catholics, have an obligation to have their children baptized.

"Parents are obliged to take care that infants are baptized in the first few weeks...and to be properly prepared for it" CIC 867 #1). Canon Law (868 #1) further states that there should be an assurance that the children will be brought up practicing the faith. If such hope is lacking, baptism is to be delayed until such assurance is present.

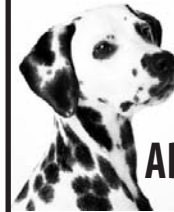
