REFLECTIONS ON STEWARDSHIP

Since evangelization is a core aspect of stewardship we should heed the words of St. Paul who says "woe to me if I do not proclaim the Gospel!" Firstly, in order for us to encourage people to follow Christ we must take the time to journey with them. It is in these interactions that they will be able to see the joy and love that emanates from the presence of Christ within us.

DOCTRINAL CORNER

Is it ok to own a Rosary for artistic display or hang on the rearview mirror of cars?

Yes, it is as long as the Rosary is given due respect and reverence.

Can angels appear in the shape of animals, such as a dog or a cat?

An angel is a pure spirit and, as such, has no shape. For the purpose of interacting with us, an angel may at times assume a shape in order to fulfill the purpose God intends for the angel to accomplish. If he wants to be recognized he would surely assume a shape that would allow this, but at times an angel's visit may require him to go unrecognized. St. Paul warns us: "Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares" (Heb. 13:2). The Holy Spirit was willing to appear as a dove (cf. Mt. 3:16, Mk. 1:10, Lk. #:22, Jn. 1:32), so there's no reason in principle that an angel could not appear in animal form.
