REFLECTIONS ON STEWARDSHIP

As we read the account of Jesus' temptation in the desert we should realize that we too have to fight temptations. When temptations come our way we must intentionally distance ourselves from the source of temptation and pray for strength. This Lent, let us begin to run away from occasions of sin and fill ourselves with good things from God instead which will slowly help us grow in holiness.

DOCTRINAL CORNER

Can mortal sins be forgiven without confession and can one go to confession online?

Sacramental confession is normatively required for the forgiveness of mortal sins. Mortal sins separate us from God and community and the healing of this rift must begin in the heart of the penitent by way of contrition, then confession and restitution. It was Jesus' command that the apostles forgive sins - or to refuse forgiveness as their judgment dictated. The priest, who acts in the person of the merciful and forgiving Jesus, acts also in His stead to forgive sins, and as a representative of the Church, to reconcile the penitent to the community. Thus sacramental confession is normally required for the forgiveness of mortal sins. In extreme cases, like in the case of a dying person who has no access to a priest, his mortal sins may be forgiven if he truly repents for his sins and has at least the implicit intention of going to sacramental confession when the earliest opportunity comes.

Online confession **is not possible**. For one to receive the sacrament he must be physically present with the minister.
