REFLECTIONS ON STEWARDSHIP

In today's first reading we hear about how Moses received the Ten Commandments from God on Mount Sinai. As we are in this penitential season of Lent let us take some time to reflect on how well we are living up to these commandments through an examination of conscience. Let us then avail ourselves to the sacrament of Confession so that the Lord can victoriously heal us of our sins, helping us grow in holiness.

DOCTRINAL CORNER

Does Jesus suffer each time we sin?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Since our sins made the Lord suffer the torment of the cross, those who plunge themselves into disorders and crimes crucify the Son of God anew in their hearts and hold Him up to contempt. Our crime in this case is greater in us than in the Jews who, according to the witness of the Apostle, "None of the rulers of this age understood this, for if they had they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.' We, however, profess to know him. And when we deny Him by our deeds, we, in some way, seem to lay violent hands on Him. Nor did the demons crucify Him; it is you who have crucified Him and crucify Him still". (CCC 598, quoting St. Francis of Assisi)
