

#### REFLECTIONS ON STEWARDSHIP

In the first reading, God tells the prophet Jeremiah, "But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people." For the Lord to insist on writing the law on our hearts. He implies that this covenant will be extremely personal and intimate. Let us strive to go to Him and bear our heart to Him, that we may be able to grow deeper in relationship with Christ.

# DOCTRINAL CORNER

#### Is it true that the Catholic Church does not emphasize reading the Bible?

This is a common misconception. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "The Church forcefully and specifically exhorts all the Christian faithful ... to learn the surpassing knowledge of Jesus Christ by frequent reading of the divine Scriptures. Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ" CCC 133). The Handbook for Indulgences explains: "A partial indulgence is granted the Christian faithful who reads Sacred Scripture with the veneration due God's word and as a form of spiritual reading. The indulgence will be a plenary one when such reading is for at least one-half hour" (p.80)
