

Do those who die in mortal sin get a second chance to repent?

At the last moment it <u>may</u> be possible to repent. But some people die so quickly that they may not have that moment. If a person dies as God's enemy – which is what we are in mortal sin – then he goes to hell by his own choice. **All of us have a lifetime to choose Him.**

Where did people who died before Christ go?

Before the Resurrection, Abraham, Noah, Moses, and all the righteous, were in the limbo of the Father (limbus Patrum) where they remained until "in His human soul united to His Divine Person, the dead Christ went to the realm of the dead. He opened heaven's gates for the just who had gone before Him (CCC 637). This explains the phrase in the Creed, *"He descended into hell, --* the realm of death, not hell as we commonly understand it, which is a place of eternal suffering and damnation.

In today's Gospel Jesus says "Abide in me as I abide in you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in

me." We can abide in Jesus by placing ourselves in His presence whenever we pray and He likewise abides in us, especially through receiving Him in the Eucharist. This close relationship with Jesus is where our stewardship originates and is sustained so let us never fail to go to Him before we offer up our time and talents to the parish.
