Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord and today's Gospel is the final event of the Epiphany: Jesus' baptism at the river Jordon by John. The fact that Mark begins his Gospel with the baptism of Jesus indicates the importance of this event. In the "renting of the sky," the Spirit "descending on him like a dove" and the voice heard from the heavens. God "anoints" His Messiah (the word Messiah means "anointed") for the work He is about to do.

In baptism, we claim the name of Christian and embrace all that that holy name means: to live for others rather than for ourselves, in imitation of Christ. Our baptism made each one of us the "servant" of God to bring forth in our world the justice, reconciliation and enlightenment of Christ, the "beloved Son" and "favor" of God.

Liturgically, the Christmas season officially comes to an end with today's Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Now the same Spirit that "anoints" the Messiah for his mission calls us to be about the work of Christmas in this new year: to seek out and find the lost, to heal the hurting, to feed the hungry, to free the imprisoned, to rebuild families and nations, to bring the peace of God to all peoples everywhere. On this feast of the Baptism of the Lord, let us pray for each of us to be faithful to the baptismal call to love and serve God and to love and serve one another.

Week of Prayer for Christian Unity:



Every year between January 18-25, Christians around the world are invited to celebrate a Week of Prayer for the unity of all Christians. The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity was first proposed in

1908 as an observance within the Roman Catholic Church. Since the founding of the World Council of Churches in 1948, many other Christian denominations around the world have come to celebrate the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. The theme for the 2025 Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is "Do you believe this?" This theme comes from the dialogue between Jesus and Martha, moments before Lazarus is raised from the dead (John 11:26.) The 2025 theme invites Christians to reflect on their common faith and to deepen their understanding of the faith that unites them. The year 2025 marks the 1,700th anniversary of the First Ecumenical Council, held in Nicaea in 325 AD, which provides a unique opportunity to celebrate the common faith of Christians. Let us pray for greater unity and solidarity among all Christians, called to proclaim the mighty acts of God.


