A few years ago, I was fortunate to visit the shrine of the Our Lady of Lourdes in France and experience first-hand the faith of so many pilgrims who come to Mary's shrine seeking comfort and peace. It was one of the most beautiful experiences for me to stand before our Lady at the grotto and pray.

The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church.
