Our Catholic School communities in Ontario celebrate this week as Catholic Education Week. This week provides an opportunity for the inclusion of all the partners in the Catholic education triad home, parish, school - to celebrate our publiclyfunded Catholic schools. The theme for this year's Catholic Education Week is "Pilgrims of Hope," which of course, is drawn from the Holy Jubilee Year proclaimed by our beloved Pope Francis, called home to the Lord just a couple of weeks ago. Reflecting on the theme, His Eminence Frank Cardinal Leo writes, "The vital partnership between parish, home, and school reflects our shared calling to be pilgrims of hope, journeying alongside one another. In this Holy Year, we are reminded that hope is not passive; it is not simply an optimistic outlook; rather, it is an active trust in God's mercy and a bold witness to his love.
