### **Season of Creation 2025**

The Season of Creation 2025 runs from **September 1**, a day marked as the World Day

of Prayer for the Care of Creation to October 4, the day on which we celebrate the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, the patron Saint of ecology. At its origins, the Season of Creation began with the Ecumenical Patriarch Dimitrios I announcing a 'Day of Prayer for Creation' for the Orthodox Church on September 1, 1989, and many major European churches followed, embracing it as part of their calendar in 2001. The Catholic Church officially adopted the Season of Creation in 2015 coinciding with the encyclical "Laudato Si." The Season of Creation challenges the entire global Christian family and the human family in general to care for God's creation through prayer and action. In his message for the 10th World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, Pope Leo XIV, "denounces environmental and social injustice, noting that God's creation is not intended to be a battleground for vital resources." May this season help us all to grow in our appreciation of God's creation and to be good and caring stewards of God's creation that sustains us.


