Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

An interview with the Pastor to set the baptism date is mandatory. Following the interview, attendance by the Parents and Catholic Godparents at Baptism Preparation Class, held every First Saturday of the month, is required. Parents of the child to be *baptized are expected to be active members of the Parish community.*

Marriage One year notice is normally required to prepare to receive this sacrament. Please contact the Parish Office to schedule a meeting with the Pastor for an initial interview.

Pastoral Care of the Sick. Requests for visitation of the sick and/or to receive the sacraments for the sick and homebound are to be made through the Parish Office. In times of emergency or beyond regular office hours, please contact a Priest in person.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults An interview with the Pastor is mandatory.



Matthew 5:13-16



A BRIEF BIOGRAPHY OF
FR. MARTIN SOOSAI, C.S.C.

Fr. Martin Soosai was born on 19 September 1977 in Tamil Nadu, India. He is the second of three sons born to Mr. Manickam Soosai and Mrs. Joesphine Selvi, who nurtured in their children a deep faith. Sensing a call to religious life, he entered the Congregation of Holy Cross in 1993 after completing Grade Ten. He made his First Profession as a member of the Congregation of Holy Cross on 28 May 1998. Following his initial formation, he pursued studies in philosophy and theology, culminating in his ordination to the priesthood in India on 27 October 2007.

Fr. Martin holds master's degrees in both Education and English Literature, academic paths that have enriched his ministry with a passion for teaching. For fourteen years (2007-2021), he served in the educational apostolate of the Congregation, including appointments as principal of two high schools in the Indian states of Telangana and Maharashtra. In addition to his educational ministry, Fr. Martin also served the Congregation as Vicar of the Province of South India for three years (2022-2025). Responding to the call to serve beyond his home country, Fr. Martin came to Canada to help in pastoral ministry, embodying the Holy Cross charism to make God known, loved, and served.




